OFFICIAL RULES

- 1. The workshops are organised by the Zbigniew Seifert Foundation.
- 2. Only persons who send their Application Forms as required by the Organiser and pay the relevant fee shall have the right to participate in the workshops.
- 3. The number of workshop participants is limited. The sole submission of the Application Form shall not guarantee the participation in the event. Only persons who have delivered their Application Forms and payment, provided that it has been recognised to the Organiser's bank account before the lapse of the application time, shall be guaranteed the participation in the workshops.
- 4. The workshops may be attended only by adult persons.
- 5. Workshops participants shall incur additional costs, such as meals, travel costs (including local transport on the route Krakow-Lusławice-Krakow), insurance etc. The Organiser provides free accommodation in the Krzysztof Penderecki European Centre for Music in Lusławice.
- 6. The bank transfers shall indicate the name and surname of the participant.
- 7. The Organiser shall have the right to finish the workshops application procedure if the number of participants reaches the maximum allowed number.
- 8. The Organiser shall have the right to cancel the event if the number of participants is too small to cover the organisation costs. In such case, the Organiser shall return the money received for the purpose to persons who submitted for the workshops.
- 9. In the event of resignation from the workshops later than by 30 June 2015, the participant shall not be entitled to any reimbursement.
- 10. The Organiser shall have the right to introduce changes to the workshops schedule.
- 11. The Organiser shall not be held responsible for any accidents during the workshops.
- 12. The Organiser shall not be held responsible for any damage or loss of workshop participants' property, as well as for any damage caused by participants during the workshops.
- 13. It is hereby forbidden to record or otherwise register the workshop classes without the Organiser's written consent.
- 14. Application to the workshops is equivalent to acknowledging and accepting these Official Rules and equivalent to a consent to process personal data by the Organiser for information and marketing purposes, in accordance with the Personal Data Protection Act of 29 August 1997, Dz. U. [Journal of Laws] No. 101, item 926.
- 16. The workshops participants consent to free of charge use of their image for the purposes of workshops promotion, in the event of online transmission, publication of photos and film from the workshops and side events organised by the Zbigniew Seifert Foundation and its patrons.
- 17. The Participants agree that the classes are open to the public and consent to the registration thereof.
